Palác Astra, Prague 1, Václavské náměstí 2



Euro Palace and Astra Palace are among the most attractive office and retail spaces on Wenceslas Square. Unlike other buildings in this location, they are not enclosed by a courtyard, which allows them to offer a first-class view of Wenceslas Square and Jungmann Square. In addition, these buildings are highly flexible and efficient in terms of spatial arrangement.

The Astra Palace, also known as the Lindt House, is the first functionalist building built in Prague in 1925-1927 for August Lindt, a manufacturer and dealer in artificial flowers. It was sensitively renovated in 2011 and today offers modern and high-quality premises.

The Euro Palace, built in 2002, is located on the west side of the lower part of Wenceslas Square. Its transparent glass shell and golden tower make it exceptional from an architectural point of view. Thanks to its excellent accessibility, the entrance to the subway is next to the reception, it has become the home of important companies since its opening. In 2002, he won several architectural awards, including the Prestigious Grand Prix of the Community of Architects.
